Film Society and Center for Community Arts Present Free Movie Premiere and New Dance Performance

(Cape May, NJ) See what happens when two art disciplines come together when the Cape May Film Society and Center for Community Arts (CCA) host the movie premiere of “Harvesting Synergy,” a live dance performance and film presentation. The show will take place on Saturday, November 8, at 7:00 p.m. at West Cape May Elementary. The work showcases the dancing talents of youth ages 10 through 14 as well as the filmmaking talents of adults and youth from throughout the community. Participants include youth from CCA’s Saturday Night YAP program in Cape May, Lower Township and Wildwood. The filmmaking class for adults and teens is one of CCA’s Fall Adult Arts Classes and was held in partnership with Cape May Lutheran Church.

“Between the rhythm of the percussionists and the great dancing, you really want to move, and the cinematography is just as moving!” says Chase Jackson, Director of Arts Programs for the Center for Community Arts. “And the night will be marked by a live performance as well as the screening. It’s going to be a great night of entertainment.”
